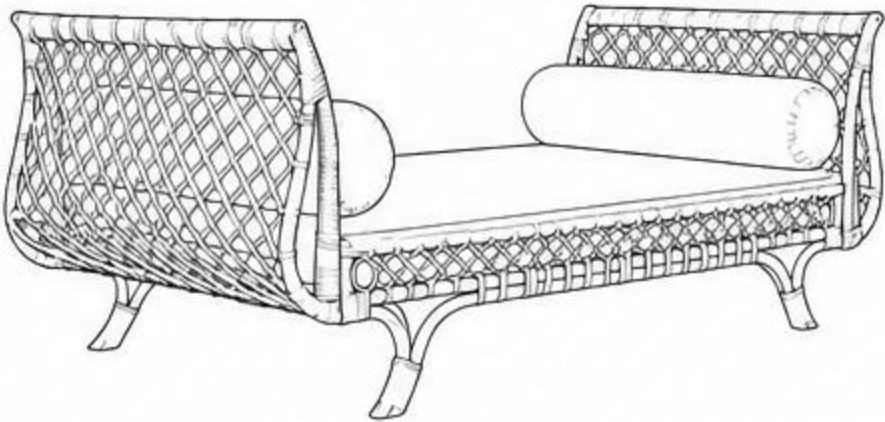


DAYBED

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

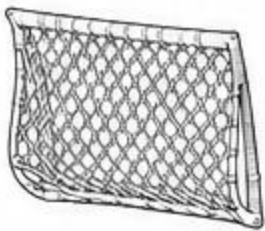


Please read all instructions before assembly.
Assemble on a clean, soft surface to avoid scratches or damage.

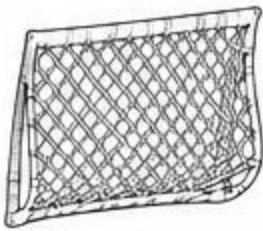


PARTS INCLUDED

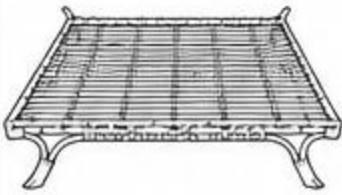
A. Left Side Panel

x1



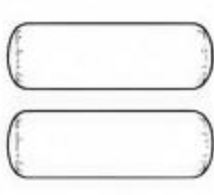
C. Bed Frame

x2



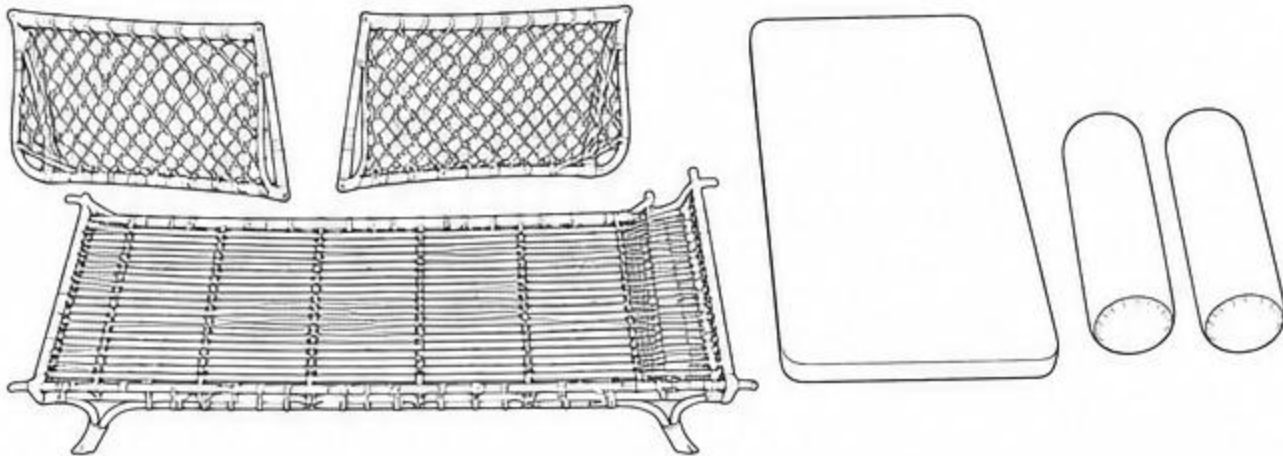
HARDWARE REQUIRED



- 10 x Bolts (5 per side)
- Allen Key (Included)

STEP 1 PREPARE ALL COMPONENTS

Lay all components on a clean, flat surface.
You should have all the parts as shown on the right before beginning assembly.



Note: Do not fully tighten the bolts until all bolts have been inserted.

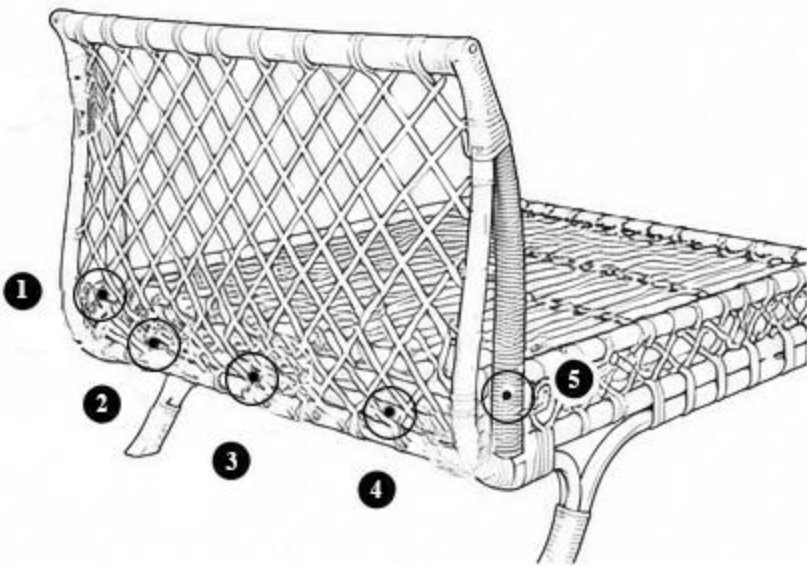
STEP 2 ATTACH THE SIDE PANELS

1. Position one side panel against the side of the bed frame.
2. Align the pre-drilled holes on the side panel with the corresponding holes on the bed frame.
3. Insert the bolts through the aligned holes.
4. Repeat the same procedure for the opposite side panel.

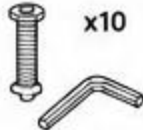
Each side panel is secured using 5 bolts, for a total of 10 bolts.

BOLT LOCATIONS (PER SIDE)

- 1 One bolt near the upper front section
- 2 Three bolts evenly spaced along the lower curved frame
- 3 One bolt at the rear vertical frame

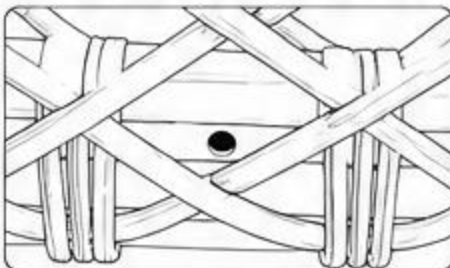


Use the Allen key to tighten all bolts securely.

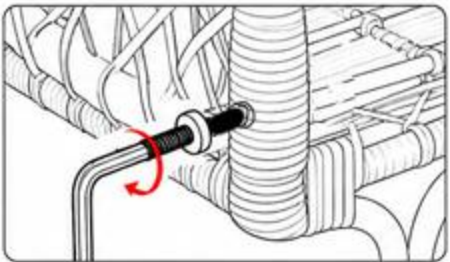


Important: Ensure both side panels are fully seated against the bed frame before final tightening.

DETAIL: BOLT CONNECTION

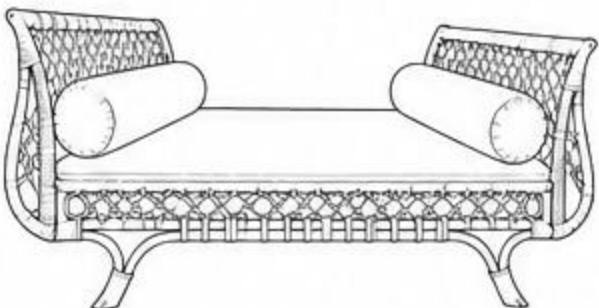


Insert the bolt through the holes and tighten using the Allen key.



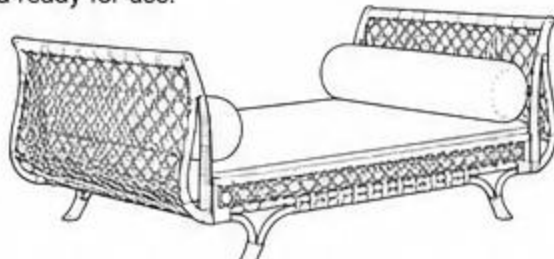
STEP 3 INSTALL THE CUSHIONS

1. Place the seat cushion evenly on the bed frame.
2. Position the two bolster pillows against the backrests as desired.



ASSEMBLY COMPLETE

Your daybed is now fully assembled and ready for use.



SAFETY NOTES



Check that all bolts are securely tightened before use.



Place the daybed on a flat, stable surface.



Re-tighten all hardware periodically during regular use.



Do not stand or jump on the daybed.



Keep small hardware away from children during assembly.
