

0110-9 Twin Twin Bunk Bed

Assembly Instructions

SAFETY WARNING

1. Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
6. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
7. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
8. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
9. Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
10. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
11. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
12. The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
13. **STRANGULATION HAZARD**—Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts and jump ropes.
14. Keep these instructions for future reference.

SIZE OF MATTRESS AND FOUNDATION:

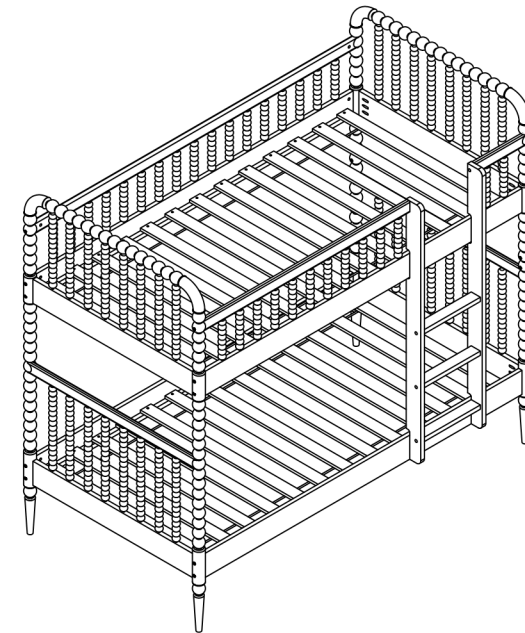
Use only mattress which is 74"-75" long and 37 1/2" - 38 1/2" wide on upper bunk. Ensure that the thickness of the mattress does not exceed 5" and mattress is at least 5" below upper edge of guardrails.

WARNING:

Adult Assembly Required. This package contains small parts. Keep away from children.

Please Note: Do not assemble using power tools. This can cause the bolts to be overtightened



Note about Warning Labeling

The warning label on your bunk bed headboard is there by law, and by law is not to be removed. The adhesive used is difficult to peel off, will tear the paper leaving a residue that is difficult to clean. We recommend that you leave it where it is.



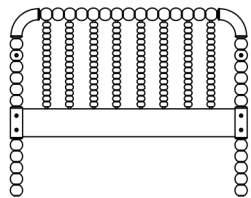
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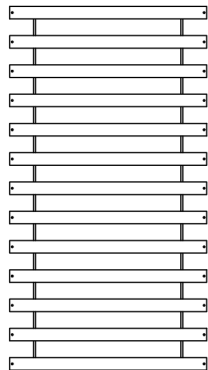

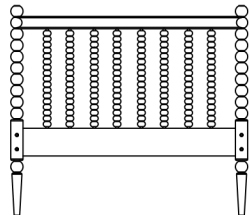


A Upper Panel

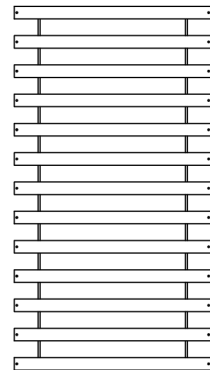


B Upper Bed Slats x 1

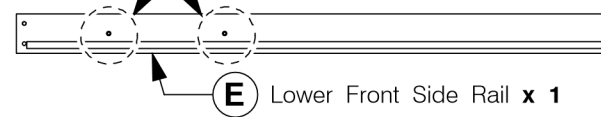
C Lower Panel

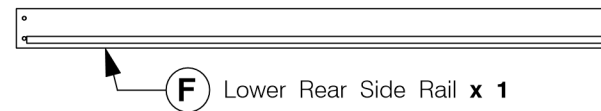
D Lower Bed Slats x 1

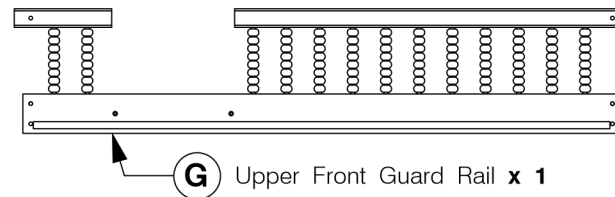

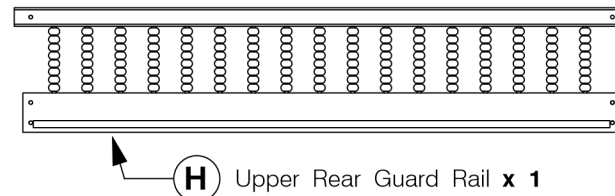
E Lower Front Side Rail x 1



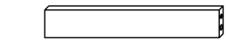
F Lower Rear Side Rail x 1



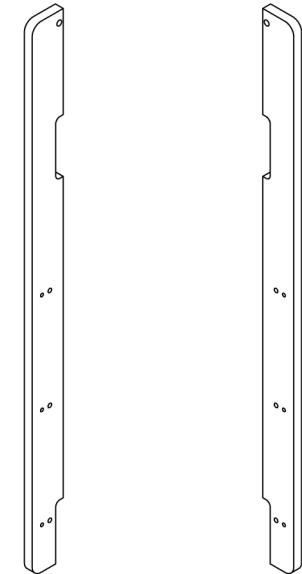
G Upper Front Guard Rail x 1

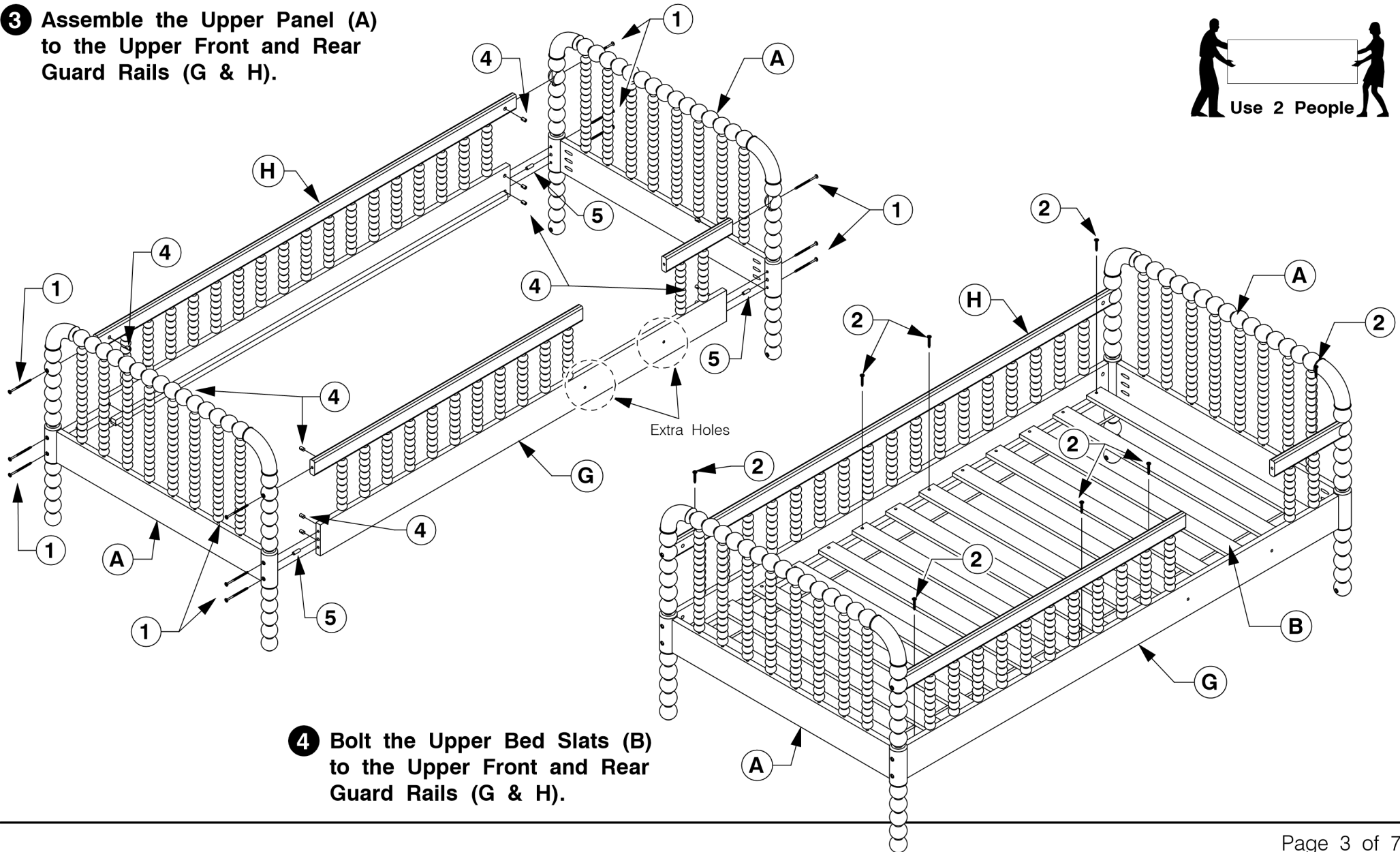
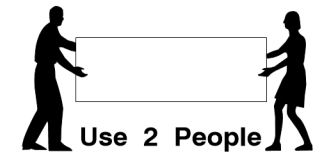
7 Allen Key x 1

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- 3** Assemble the Upper Panel (A) to the Upper Front and Rear Guard Rails (G & H).

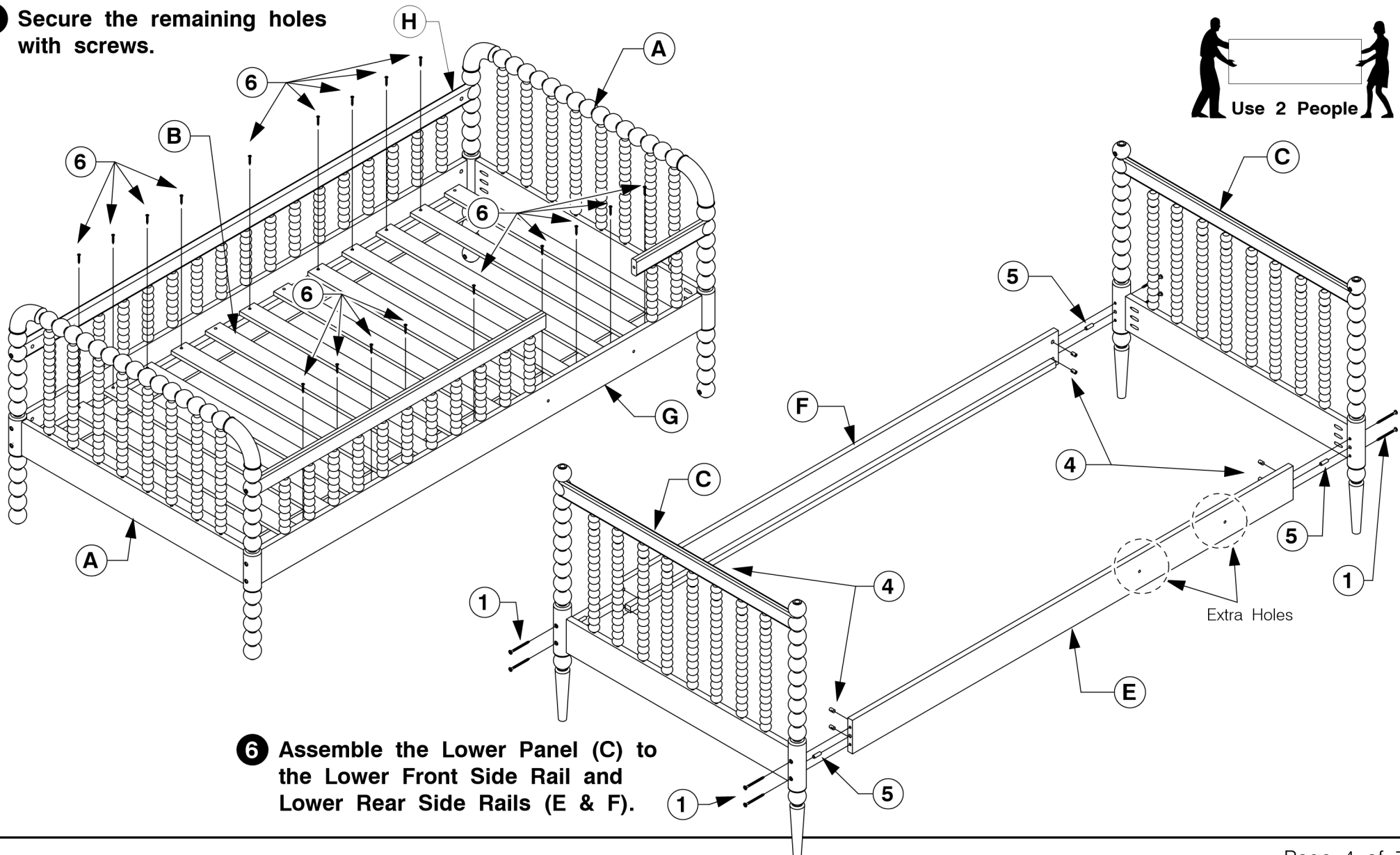
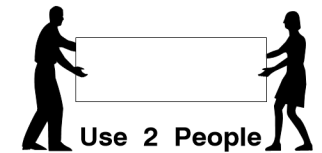


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- 5** Secure the remaining holes with screws.

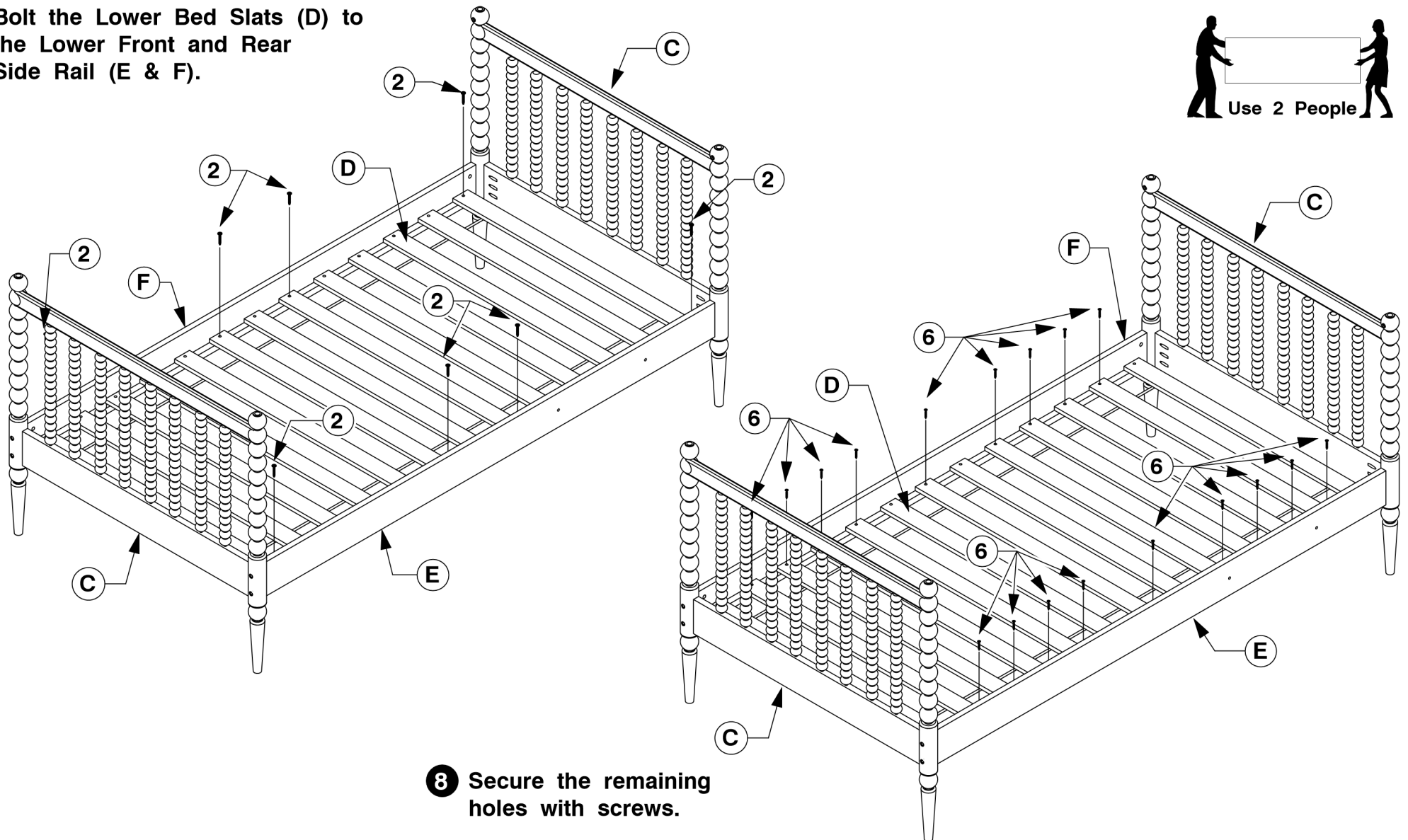
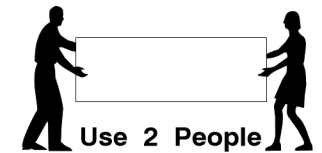


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- 7** Bolt the Lower Bed Slats (D) to the Lower Front and Rear Side Rail (E & F).



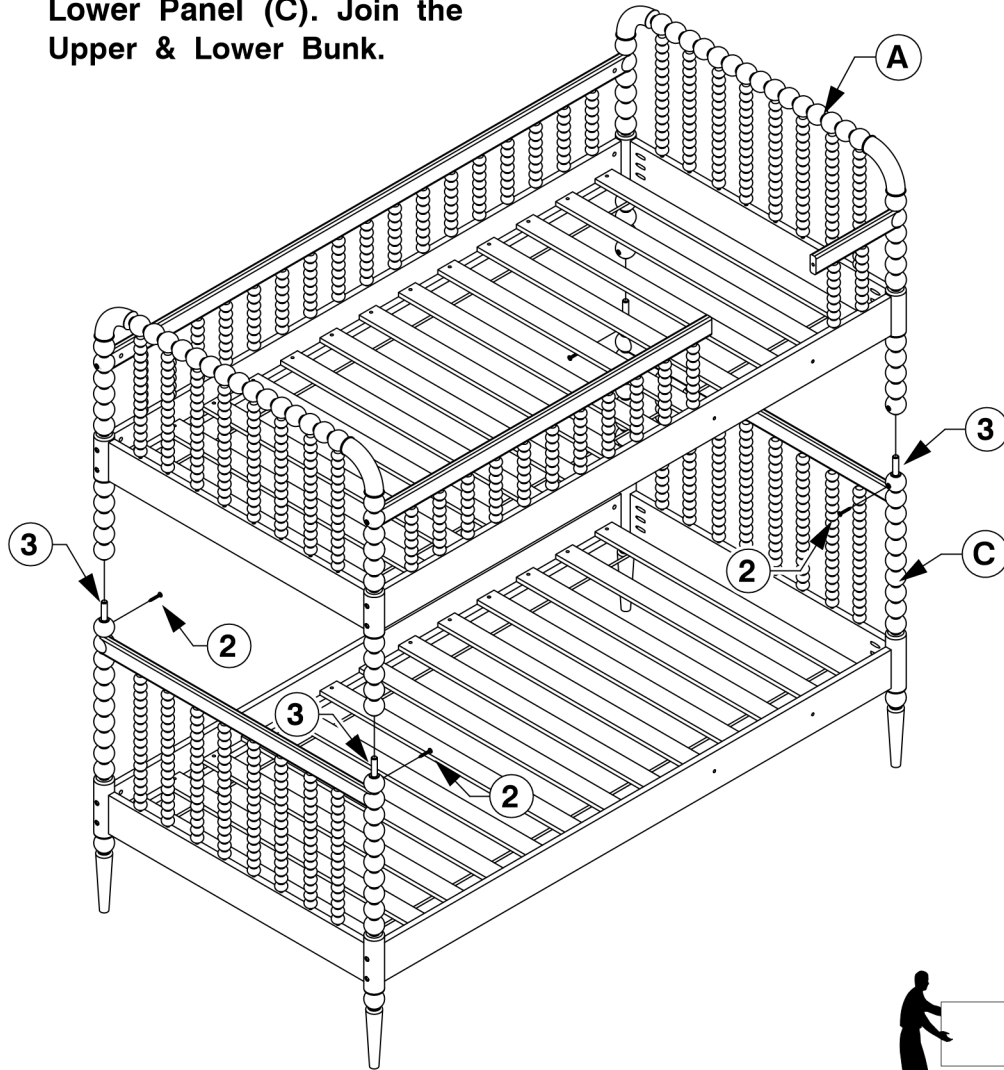
- 8** Secure the remaining holes with screws.

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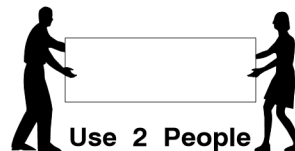
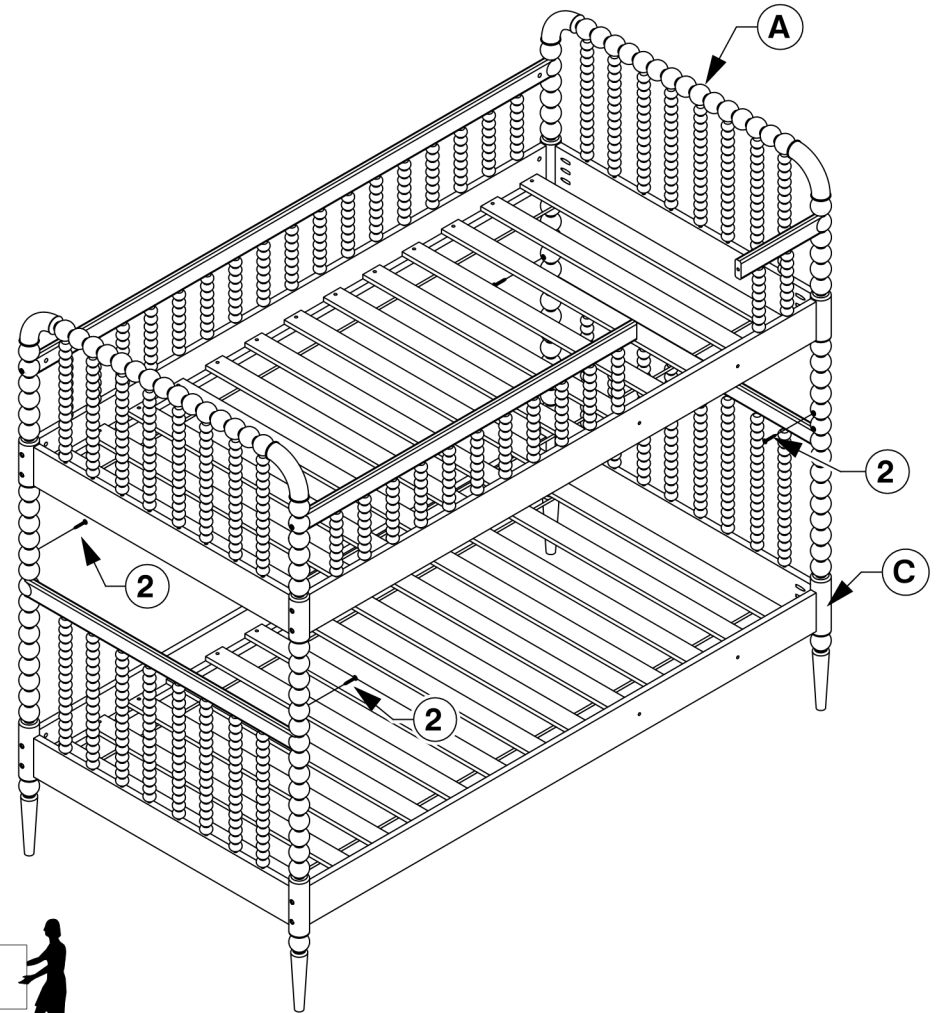
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- 9** Fit the Metal Pin (3) to the Lower Panel (C). Join the Upper & Lower Bunk.



- 10** Fasten bolts into the remaining holes as shown.
